

The Streetsville Founders' Bread and Honey Festival will be held on Saturday, June 3rd and Sunday, June 4th. The arts and crafts will be located on the island in the Streetsville Memorial Park.

We are pleased to let you know that the cost for you to participate in our festival has gone down. Please read the info below to ensure you understand the application process and requirements for the City of Mississauga City's Special Event Licence exemption.

**Festival Space Fee**

\$101.75 + HST = \$115.00 (for both Saturday and Sunday)

**Insurance**

a) If you have insurance already, have your **insurance company** fill out the Certificate of Insurance Coverage Form for the City of Mississauga and enclose with your festival application.

b) If you do not have insurance and wish to purchase it from the City of Mississauga, please make a cheque out to the **City of Mississauga** and mail it with your application form. Choose one of the scenarios which suits your products:

You are selling products that are not edible: \$21.60

You are selling products that are edible by humans or pets: \$54.00

**City of Mississauga Special Event Licence - *New***

If you do not fall under one of the exemptions below, the cost of the licence is \$31.00 - add this to your festival fee (cheque made out to the Streetsville Founders' Bread and Honey Festival) and send with your application form.

Exemption scenarios and documents required as proof of exemption:

Scenario	Required Proof and/or Documentation
Holds an annual licence from the City of Mississauga for the vehicle/cart <b>being used at the event</b>	Copy of annual licence
Is a Farmer Grows products in Ontario Sells only what is proprietarily grown	Must not be found selling 3rd party produce
The goods are manufactured /produced in Ontario and are being sold in Mississauga where the producer lives	Home address information PLUS sales invoice with address, website address with sales locations, etc.
The applicant pays Mississauga Business taxes	Business tax submission

Fill out the Bread and Honey Application form. Please read all instructions carefully to ensure you are enclosing the correct fee(s) along with pictures of your products for first time vendors, proof of documentation required for the City of Mississauga Licence Exemption or the licence fee and your insurance certificate.

Mail all forms, cheques, documents to the address on the application form - 13 Rapallo Mews, Mississauga, ON L5N 1K8

Print off the Important Information which contains information on location, set up and take down, vendor responsibilities and amenities at the Festival.

Remember, participation in previous years does not guarantee a spot as space is limited and space allocation is first come, first served.

All crafts must be made in Canada and be of your own origin. The contents of any gift basket must be handmade, not purchased goods. If you participated in the Bread and Honey Festival last year, you are not required to send photographs unless your product has changed.

We are happy to report this event regularly entertains 40,000 people over the weekend.

We look forward to having you with us as we celebrate our 45th Annual Bread and Honey Festival.
